## Part 3: A King Like No Other

### Introduction

For the next three weeks we're looking at these gifts that some wise men gave to Jesus. Most of us know what they are, but do we know what they mean? God prophetically announces the Jesus to come with the gifts given to his son. Let's explore them together.

### Discussion Questions

1. What's your favorite Christmas tradition? If you were one of the wise men, what gift would you have brought Jesus?
2. Jesus is a king like no other. What are some things about Jesus' life that were unexpected? What do those things tell you about who He is?
3. We can have three responses to Jesus' kingship: opposition, dismissal, and worship. Have you ever opposed or dismissed Jesus? What led you to eventually worship Him instead? How do you most enjoy worshiping Jesus?
4. What are some ways you can bow down and worship Jesus this Christmas season?

How can you share Jesus with your friends and family this Christmas season? Make time to worship Jesus this week, and share some ways He's changed your life with your friends and family.
