## **THE CHOSEN** 112

This Sunday school class gathers to watch episodes of The Chosen together, followed by insightful discussions that delve into its themes and messages. Participants explore how the series illuminates biblical narratives and deepens their understanding of faith in contemporary contexts.

## **FRIENDS IN FAITH** 123

This class is tailored for young families, focusing on flourishing as individuals, in marriages, and as parents through thoughtful discussions and practical insights. It provides a supportive environment where participants can grow together in their personal and family lives.

## **EMOTIONALLY HEALTHY SPIRITUAL RELATIONSHIP CLASS** 113 A-B

This class meets together to share the experience of developing emotionally healthy attachment to the TRINITY and to one another. Each week the group gathers to invite the Holy Spirit into the conversation of how do we become more like the character of Jesus by understanding the way we are wired to build healthy, mature, joyful attachment and to live out I Corinthians 13.

## **YOUNG ADULTS** 109A-B

This Sunday school class, comprised of young adults, engages in lively discussions on theology alongside practical life issues. Participants explore how faith intersects with everyday challenges, seeking deeper understanding and application of biblical principles in their lives.

## **CHRISTIAN COMPANIONS** 119-120

This Sunday school class, composed of individuals aged 30-60, gathers to study the Bible collaboratively and to pray together. Participants deepen their understanding of Scripture and strengthen their faith through mutual support and shared prayer.

## **PATHFINDERS CLASS** 117A-B

This Sunday school class, predominantly comprised of senior adults aged 60 and above, focuses on in-depth studies of various books of the Bible. Participants gather to explore and discuss Scripture together, drawing insights and enriching their faith journeys through the wisdom of their years.

## **THE CLASSROOM** 121

This Sunday school class explores ways to engage contemporary culture with timeless truths from Scripture, fostering discussions that bridge faith and everyday life. Participants examine current issues through a biblical lens, seeking to apply these insights in relevant and impactful ways.

## **LADIES LOVING CHRIST SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS** 128

This Sunday school class, consisting of older women aged 60 and above, gathers for fellowship and mutual support, sharing in prayer and encouragement for each other's lives. Together, they deepen their relationships with God and with one another through shared experiences and spiritual growth.
